Transport and Travel – learn about early forms of transport and how modes of transport have changed over the years.

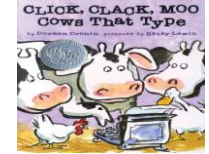
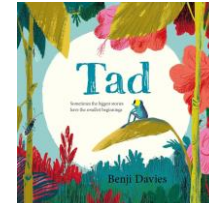
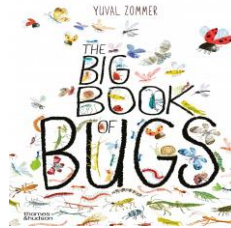
