This term we have raised £1,461.95 as a result of several events¹, including movie night, Mother's Day present making, and the school disco. Included in this are several donations following successful application to external funders including the Leighton Buzzard Rotary Club. Thank you to all those who took part.

All of this has required a good deal of effort from the PTA and the school staff who have volunteered their time to run these activities.

We have spent the funds raised on a number of resources that all of the children benefit from, including:

- Kapow Primary - Art, Design and Technology, and Languages Scheme and resources
