Dear Parents and Carers,

Personal, Social and Health Education and Relationships and Sex Education (RSHE)

As part of the school improvement process we regularly monitor and evaluate our curriculum to ensure we are offering the best possible education for our pupils. This means that our curriculum is often evolving and developing.

From January 2022 we will be using a new framework to teach PSHE and RSHE in school.
